[Like other commodities, urban space is an outcome of production relations. Therefore it is necessary to understand the relations among the factors of production, namely capital, labour and land, and their transformation in time for different societies. However, the production relations are too general to understand the evolution and structuring of urban space. For this reason, the study of property relations has become most prominent in apprehending the processes producing urban space. In the study, it was observed that the terminologies for property and space had very significant similarities. Both were either things or relationships, absolute or relative, corporeal or incorporeal, abstract or concrete. Sometimes they were appropriated and sometimes dominated, while the main dualism revolved around their being private or non-private (public, common, communal, collective.) Historically the main discussion centred upon the private or non-private ownership of property objects, in which space held a very critical position.]

In the analysis of the local dynamics, the two towns appear at the different points. Bursa is one of the few towns in Turkey which made its appearance, as a strong textile town under the tutelage of several large firms for the national market before 1980n and has enjoyed further development thanks to export activities, by restructuring its industry to fit the new conditions; while Denizli, an unprecedented development initiated by its small and medium-sized textile and clothing firms, quick on the uptake of the potentialities in the new period. This difference between the two towns enables us to have a rich comparison to scrutinise the socio-spatial process. [The relations between Islam and Western world are usually examined at the macro level of political regimes, terrorism, or cultural-religious differences. This book, however, privileges the analysis of micro processes by focusing upon emerging Muslim profiles and practices in public life. Different trajectories of Muslim actors who refer to religion in shaping their personal identities and public behavior are studied in three different publics namely, secularist Turkey, Post Islamic Iran, and Europe. The authors argue that the participation of Muslim actors in public life does not represent a linear, conflict-free evolution towards modern conceptions of self and public; rather, it calls for a closer examination of new political and cultural issues raised by public claims of Muslim actors that in turn challenge the Eurocentric definitions of private-public spheres and religious-secular oppositions. Bringing researchers of

Islam together with others from outside this particular field, the book poses questions regarding the definitions of self, religion, difference, and public in such a manner that it should appeal not only to specialists of Islam, but to those interested in social scientific analysis in general as well.]
