Based on the colloquium held in Çorum in 2018, this book provides answers to these questions. In addition to landscape and settlement patterns, there are settlements, housing and engineering structures, human remains, tombs and, lastly, most importantly, objects within a very wide range of subjects. Such a study is only possible with cooperation and an interdisciplinary approach.

First, this book shows the potential that reflects the need for further exploration of the central Black Sea region and northern Central Anatolia during the Hellenistic-

Roman Period. Differences are evident here compared to the Aegean and southern coasts of Anatolia, but more detailed analyzes will be possible in the future on the basis of more extensive data. A similar pattern applies to understanding the relationship between rural areas and urban centers such as Ankyra (Ankara).

In this book, metal figurines found in Burdur Museum are introduced. The vast majority of the statuettes are bronze. Besides, there are silver, gold, lead and copper works. Find places have been added to the inventory of some figurines. However, since they came to the museum by purchasing, the find places of the majority of them are not exactly clear. With the work done, it was tried to be explained that the statuettes were captured from the Pisidia region and its surroundings. Figurines from the Pisidia Region were found from the ancient cities of Cremna, Ceraitai, Hadriani. Among the cities close to Pisidia are only finds from Cibyra. However, it should be noted that there are works that may originate from Pamphylia, Lydia, Phrygia, even if there are individual examples. The statuettes have a wide date range from the Late Bronze Age to recently. However, most of them belong to the Roman Period. In this study, 7 groups of statuettes were classified according to their periods. The 8th section consists of examining the false figurines. This book contains detailed descriptions, dimensions, views from different directions, analysis of the 66 statuettes and suggestions about where they might have been found. This book, which provides acceptable chronology and presents all the figurines in a holistic order, covers the first metal figurine work of the Pisidia Region.

This political entity founded by the Georgian Bagrationis dynasty in the early ninth century covers the modern-day provinces of Artvin, Erzurum (partially), Ardahan in Turkey, and the provinces of Samtskhe-Javakheti and Ajara in Georgia. This book contains the proceedings of the international conference on “New Perspectives for the Study of Islamic Culture, History and Art in Uzbekistan” dedicated to the memory of Academician Ubaydulla Karimov which was organized by IRCICA and Al-Biruni Institute of Oriental Studies of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan (Tashkent) online and offline, on 28 May 2021. The book, under print as the present Newsletter goes to press, includes a total of 84 articles in the Uzbek, Russian and Turkish languages, each accompanied by its abstract in English.

Academician Ubaydulla Karimov (1920-1997), to whom the conference was dedicated, is introduced at the beginning of the book by Surayyo Ubaydullaevna Karimova with a comprehensive article. Both a chemist and an orientalist, through his research work Karimov presented scholarly evidence to some important aspects of the contributions of Central Asia to world science and civilization.

The first chapter, on “History and Source Studies” contains forty articles addressing a variety of themes, from science and medicine to economy and waqfs, from influential persons and institutions to international relations, from the discovery of previously unknown works to emerging topics and new methods in Islamic studies. The twenty-nine articles presented in the second chapter are devoted to “Islamic Studies”. They result from recent research on specialized topics in the history of Quranic sciences, philosophy, natural sciences, architecture and archeology, and the heritage of medieval scientists and scholars. The third chapter contains fifteen articles in “Philology” contributed by specialists and researchers interested in the linguistic and literary processes in Central Asia.

Considering their number and remarkable diversity, this collection of articles constitutes a representative sample of current academic research activity in Uzbekistan in the fields of the humanities and social sciences relating to the history and culture of the Islamic world.

This book, entitled The Artisans and Janissaries of Istanbul: Before and After The Auspicious Event, 1808-39, tells the story of the artisans and janissaries in Istanbul during the reign of Mahmud II (r. 1808-39). It is about people like the aforementioned toymaker/seller who survived on the margins of society and were able to return to the center of Istanbul, albeit in his case as impoverished men who had to earn a living and did not have the power of armed men. The book seeks to uncover both individual and institutional hi(stories) and to show what everyday life was like before and after he Auspicious Event, and to what extent the state crushing of the janissary power paved the way for further yet complex liberalization of the Ottoman Empire and thus had an impact on the guilds and the relevant actors.

The book consists of ten chapters that are based mainly on new sources. The chapters discuss the economic activities of Jews and non-Jews in Constantinople and Smyrna during the long eighteenth century (1700-1820). The chapters also contain information relating to Salonica. The primary material for the volume was the Levant Company's official correspondence exchanged between its administration and employees, political authorities in England and the Sublime Porte. This work is based also on archival research of Jewish sources, mainly the Responsa literature, in order to understand the various topics under discussion. Jews frequently appear in these studies due to their place in local and international trade and because of the close ties between Jewish brokers and European merchants. The ten chapters of the book are based on undisclosed documentation and deal mainly with the Jews of Constantinople and secondarily also with the Jews of Smyrna, with slight reference also to the Jews of Salonica. The purpose of the research is to point out the deep involvement of the Jews in these cities in trade and money lending, and to study the connections of Jewish brokers, merchants, and Sarrafs in the above cities with the British merchants in the period under discussion.

In the international sale of goods risk is an important concept that should not be underestimated. This is because the transfer of the sold goods from the buyer to the seller does not involve a short and easy process. During this process, the goods could be damaged or lost. Despite the contract of sale, the parties may disagree who will bear the risk when the goods are lost or damaged. Moreover, in the international sale of goods the transition of risk differs in different legal systems. It is therefore important to first understand what the risk is and then determine how and when it passes to the buyer in the legal systems involved. Besides, there is benefit in examining whether the obligations of the parties arising from the sales contract affect the transfer of risk. Knowing how risk is passed can prevent disputes in international sales law. This paper will examine in detail the passage of risk in international goods sales under CISG, Incoterms® and English law. First, a general definition of the risk will be offered, and general information will be given about how it transfers to the buyer. Then the concept of risk will be examined, first under CISG and then under the international commercial terms issued by the ICC, and how it is incorporated in international sales contracts will be discussed. Since English law applies SGA 1979 to international sales, how risk passes will also be examined

under that act. Finally I examine the consequences of the transition of risk in these three legal systems, and the convenience and difficulties involved.

Whether Turkey should be deemed as a "safe third country" for asylum seekers in Europe is a legal conundrum that deserves heightened attention with the adoption of the EU-Turkey Statement of March 2016 and EU-Turkey Readmission Agreement. This book aspires to contribute to this discussion through an analysis of Turkish judicial practices on international protection, removal and administrative detention

procedures, including their interaction with international and European framework and jurisprudence. One purpose of the book is to display the protection challenges that the safe third country concept creates through the example of Turkey. The position defended is that Turkish judicial practices or any other component of safe third country assessment such as administrative practices or normative framework should be evaluated from this perspective, by keeping in mind the inherent problems of the safe third country concept. In the assessment of Turkey's position as a safe third country for EU states, state of judiciary is a crucial factor. Judiciary acts as the ultimate safeguard for protection of rights and guiding administrative practices through interpretation of normative framework. Thus the second aim of this book is to analyze the problematic legal issues in Turkish judicial practices relevant to international protection, removal and administrative detention, based on an empirical study of decisions of Turkish courts. The empirical method in the qualitative analysis of Turkish jurisprudence is supported with a comparative analysis of the case law of the European Court of Human Rights, Court of Justice of the EU as well as the domestic jurisprudence of EU states.

This book argues that the late Ottoman constitutional reforms (i) were carried out as a consequence of the metamorphosis of the Empire into a modern state, (ii) were considerably in favour of the bureaucratic class, (iii) were paying regard to the expectations of the Ottoman and the Western public, and most importantly (iv) had been in conformity with Islamic jurisprudence. The constitutional reforms in the late Ottoman Empire on fundamental rights and freedoms were an idiosyncratic reflection of a trans-regional political paradigm shift. Most of the reforms were carried out in conformity with Islamic jurisprudence that had been continuously

implemented in the Ottoman judicial system for centuries. The majority of the legislation was nothing but a codification of Islamic principles of jurisprudence. Yet some of them were quite new to the system, such as legislation on imprisonment and custody. Nevertheless, these new systems were adapted to Islamic jurisprudence. Moreover, the new regime of the protection of human rights brought an innovation to the judicial system concerning bureaucrats' fundamental rights. These reforms reflected a significant effort for the adjustment of the new Ottoman administrative practices to the principles of Islamic jurisprudence.

Maqāma, as one of the most original genres of Arabic literature, was also written in Hebrew, Syriac, and Persian. However, no original maqāma written in Turkish has hitherto been encountered. This research reveals a formerly unknown Turkish maqāma and presents its full text transliterated into Latin script and translation into modern Turkish and English. The maqāma, written by the 17th-century Turkish poet Nev'izāde Atāyī, deals with a woman and her husband who appealed to a court seeking divorce. In the presence of a judge and other witnesses, they extol their own virtues and besmirch each other's evils in a highly artistic and entertaining manner. This maqāma echoes Hamadānī's "Shamiyya," al-Harīrī's "Tabriziyya" (Arabic) and Hamīdī's "Hukumat al-Zawjayn" (Persian) in both style and theme. Therefore, this study also compare Turkish maqāma with Arabic and Persian counterparts, and uncover a successfully enriched example that handles a classical maqāma topic while simultaneously adhering to the technical features of the genre in a new language.
