[This book addresses the issue of harmonization between development and environmental conservation in biological production as one of the subjects of global concern. Since agricultural production plays an important role particularly in developing countries, studies on the sustainability of agricultural production system become essential. The book comprises the results of studies examining the measures for establishing a sustainable agricultural production system while conserving the fragile natural environment. The book provides an interesting "different story" of rural development since java is taken as the study case. As already well known, Java is the most highly populated island in Indonesia where conflicts between agricultural development and environmental conservation have severely taken place.

The book contains four big research themes, namely (1) studies of environmental change and sustainable development (2) studies of sustainable use of botanical resources on arable land, (3) socioeconomic studies of sustainable development in rural Indonesia, and (4) landscape – ecological studies of sustainable bio-resource management systems in Indonesia.]

[This book presents a broad description and analysis of Indonesia's pattern and policies of industrialisation, in particular during the 1970s and early 1980s. From the experiences drawn options for future industrial development are assessed. In this manner the study is meant to contribute to the search for more appropriate industrialisation strategies in Indonesia as well as to the formulation of national policies for industrial development.

Part I of the book describes industrialisation strategies pursued in Indonesia as presented in its national plan documents, industrialisation experiences in other developing countries, and summarises economic developments in Indonesia during the 1970s and early 1980s.

Part II deals with the structure and pattern of industrial development and includes chapters on the growth and composition of the manufacturing sector in Indonesia, regional issues of industrialisation, the role and contribution of small-scale industries, private foreign investment, and capacity in manufacturing.

Part III focuses on linkages within the manufacturing sector and with the productive sectors, examines interindustry linkage effects, and analyses different components contributing to the growth of the manufacturing sector. Moreover, total factor intensities are assessed.

Part IV discusses issues with respect to trade in manufactures, reviewing import and export performance of manufacturing and analysing Indonesia's comparative advantage and prospective export markets, and examines Indonesia's export promotion policies.

Part V presents projections of manufacturing growth according to different industrialisation strategies, and includes a summary of conclusions and recommendations.]
