[The author started the study of various ethnic tribes living in the country as a hobby in 1952 and continued throughout the course of 34 years of government service at the Ministry of Culture. The culmination of these efforts was a book titled "National Races of Myanmar" published in 1960 by the Ministry of Culture, which has to this day remained as the key reference work, both domestically and internationally, on the various ethnic groups of Myanmar.

Within the course of 30 years, new sub-groups of Chins, Palaungs, Lisus and Kayahs were discovered. In the Yaw region new sub-groups of Taungthars were also discovered. Photographic evidence of White Pa Os, Tarons, Zayeins, various sub-groups of the Chins in the Matupi and Kanpetlet regions and other new Shan sub-groups in the Shan State were obtained. Photographic evidence of the "Eng" was acquired only in 1998.

Finally, this book covers 129 tribes out of 135 and it is one and only book on the subject ever published. Hundreds of black and white and some colour photos give a very impressive works of the author.]

[The final British conquest of Burma came in 1885. It was a brief and bloodless campaign Mandalay fell to the British in a fortnight's time, their casualties numbering 4 killed and 27 wounded in the Battle-of Minhla, the major engagement of the campaign.

But the conquest suddenly turned into a military nightmare for the British. General Prendergast, leading the expedition was recalled ending his military career in disgrace. Sir Frederick Roberts of Kandahar fame, Commander-in-Chief India himself took active command in the field. The original expeditionary force of 10,000 was swollen to 32,000 and reinforced by a military police 26,000 strong.

The reason was a vast upsurge of national resistance to uphold the religion to uphold the national honour to uphold the country's interests.

It was a struggle pitting muskets and swords against rifles and machine guns, but the Burmese threw into the balance a spirit of indomitable resistance and tactics well-adapted to the environment. It was a struggle which drew in a great variety of men and threw up a great many heroes, but it was, in essence a struggle of the common man fighting for what he felt to be his national identity.]
