[Food policy analysts and government policy makers have different views on food security. Those who decide for agriculture in less developed countries equate food security with self-sufficiency and look at food, particularly food grains, as political commodities while food policy analysts put premium on income in gauging food security based on the claim that poverty is the main cause of food insecurity. The latter view accords well with internationally accepted definition of food security that evolved through time in conjunction with the changing world food situation.
