[This book – set has been published as part of the research programme on “the Marches of the Dai Viet Empire”, a joint initiative of the Vietnam National Centre for Social Science and Humanities, the Hanoi Centre of the EFEO and the research group “Peninsule Indochinoise” in the Forth Section of the E’cole Pratique des Hautes E’tud and the EfEO. It is made up of three volumes : two volumes of text (I,II) and one volume of maps (III). The volumes of text are divided into three different parts. There is the annotated translation into modern Vietnamese followed by a reproduction of the original text in characters, the translations into English and French, and finally a complete index in Vietnamese and characters. The maps were printed a part from the text (Volume III) allowing the reader to view both the text and the map at the same time, permitting a parallel reading of the document which corresponds perfectly to the classical conception of geography, for which text and image were inseparable. Rather than follow the alphabetical order of the provinces, this edition presents the faxcicules in a geographical progression allowing the reader to follow the maps and their description across the Red River Delta, up into the highlands. From the Northeast to the Northwest, down to the Northern middle region, and then into the central carridor of Vietnam at Thanh Hoa, following it as far South as Thua Thien Hua.
