The subject of this study is a small collection of songs known as Caragiti, 'songs of the mystic path', or literary 'songs of the proper way of action'. Although the songs were composed perhaps sometime in the 9th-12th century CE, and thus belong to the final phase of Indian Buddhism, their authors, known as siddhas, have defied attempts of historians to place them within an exact historical context, just as they, in their own time, openly defied all religious and social conventions..
