The concept of pure economic loss draws its origin from English law. Even then, the English common law decisions on pure economic loss – for the past sixty years or so – have been swaying from one end of the equilibrium to the other. The English law established a general principle, the neighbour principle, for determining when a duty of care exists. It imposed a duty of care on manufacturers not to cause personal injury or physical damage to property through defects in their manufactured chattels.
