The vast majority of people interviewed for this study said that people with psychosocial and intellectual disabilities face stigma and discrimination in society, generally. It is inevitable that discriminatory attitudes, including widespread assumptions that such individuals lack capacity and have little to contribute to society, pervade public services and how people with psychosocial and intellectual disabilities are dealt with by public services personnel. At least until recent years, such attitudes were reflected also in national legislation which did not afford people with disabilities the same rights as were granted to those without disabilities, and frequently contained discriminatory language and provisions. The recoverability of economic loss in Malaysia is still an unsettled area of the law. Economic loss has generally not been recoverable in Malaysia. The concept of pure economic loss draws its origin from English law. Even then, the English common law decisions on pure economic loss – for the past sixty years or so – have been swaying from one end of the equilibrium to the other. The English law established a general principle, the neighbour principle, for determining when a duty of care exists. It imposed a duty of care on manufacturers not to cause personal injury or physical damage to property through defects in their manufactured chattels. However, any defect in the chattel is considered pure economic loss and has traditionally not been recoverable in tort. It is as consequence of the defect in it, the chattel inflicts injury on a person or causes damage to property other than itself, the manufacturer would be liable in negligence. The position in Malaysia appears to be no different.
